Subject: Single window Regional Port Bye-law North Sea Canal area operational commencing July 11th, 2011

The director of the public body Central Nautical Management, also the State Harbour Master, announces the following:

Commencing July 11th 2011 the single window for the Regional Port By-law North Sea Canal area will become operational.

This means that the Central Nautical Management is not only the contact point for shipping traffic management in the region, but also the single window for all operational port administration affairs, resulting from the Regional Port By-law North Sea Canal area.

On the behalf of the municipalities of Amsterdam, Beverwijk, Velsen and Zaanstad the Central Nautical Management will, on a 24/7 basis, manage all requests for permits or exemptions from the Regional Port By-law North Sea Canal area.

The Central Nautical Management is also the point of contact for all operational reports resulting from this by-law.

The nautical sector of the Port of Amsterdam is responsible for the execution of these duties.

If your request is sent outside of regular office hours (09:00 – 17:00 hours) and/or if you desire an immediate answer, make a telephone call to 020-6239130, the Port of Amsterdam, team dangerous goods and environment after mailing your request.
